InSHAPE®

Physical health initiative for adults with serious mental illness

The Heartland Family Service InSHAPE® program is a health initiative developed at Dartmouth College for adults experiencing serious mental illness. The goal of the program is to improve physical health and quality of life, reduce the risk of preventable diseases, and enhance the life expectancy of individuals living with serious mental illnesses.

Studies show that individuals with serious and persistent mental illnesses, such as schizophrenia and bipolar disorder, have a lifespan that is 20-25 years shorter than the general population. These individuals also are at an increased risk of chronic diseases, including diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular disease, and nicotine dependence.

How the Program Works

Through InSHAPE, participants will meet with a health mentor for one hour once a week for a personalized physical activity and nutrition program. To start, the health mentor will help participants create a Self Health Action Plan for Empowerment (SHAPE) that includes physical activity, healthy eating goals, and attention to medical needs, as well as implement the plan by linking the participant to already available community resources, such as gyms, parks, nutritional programs, etc.

Services Provided

The Heartland Family Service InSHAPE® program includes the following services:

- · Fitness assessments
- · Goal-setting
- · Personal training
- Nutrition and cooking education
- · Smoking cessation
- · Support in accessing and using the health care system

Eligibility

To be eligible for InSHAPE, participants must be:

- 18 years or older
- · Overweight
- · Diagnosed with a serious mental illness
- · Given medical clearance by a doctor for participation
- · Interested in working toward a healthier lifestyle
