Iowa's **Food Assistance Employment & Training** program (FA E&T) is a key resource to support Food Assistance recipients in reaching their employment goals and earning a sustainable family wage.

In partnership with community colleges across the state, the Iowa Department of Human Services administers FA E&T to provide the necessary skills, training, and support that can connect them to in-demand field and lead to economic self-sufficiency.

FA E&T participants can enter a career pathway at the point that fits their needs: **high school completion, ESL, short-term certificate, or credit degree.**
